

DECEMBER 2017 WEATHER

The January Newsletter reported the sad passing of Pam Boddy, who had written monthly reports on the Holmesfield weather for several years. I share her interest in the weather and actually look forward to the ups and downs of the seasons, unlike my wife who cannot wait for the spring and summer to come.

I am writing this note in the middle of January and right now my weather station tells me that it is 'raining cats and dogs'. That means that the rain is falling at more than 30mm per hour (more than one inch per hour) but who knows where the expression 'raining cats and dogs' comes from? Google tells me that it might refer to dead cats and dogs floating in the gutters during heavy rain, or perhaps it comes from Odin the Norse god of storms who was often pictured with cats (heavy rain) and dogs (strong winds). It might also come from the old English word catadupe which meant cataract (waterfall). Take your pick.

December 2017 was actually quite an interesting month with fairly wide swings in the weather and an almost 'White Christmas'. Overall, it finished up as an average December with a mean temperature of 4.3°C, which is slightly warmer than my average over the last 15 years, and almost average rainfall of 88mm (3½ inches). The maximum temperature was 11.9°C on the 20th and the minimum -2.7°C on the 11th of the month. If you are interested in the whole of 2017, then I can tell you that the mean temperature was 9.6°C, which is 0.3°C above my 15 year average. The windiest day was 23rd February with a maximum of 67 mph. We live on the west side of Cartledge Lane and so catch most of the winds that blow.

So people can have lots of confidence when employing one of the 1,200 traders who are part of the scheme. In the very unlikely event of someone having a problem with one of the traders then help is at hand. Derbyshire County Council trading standards officers can get involved in any queries involving Trusted Traders and seek to resolve them

The scheme particularly helps to protect older and vulnerable adults by making it easier for them to use Trusted Traders rather than rogue traders who typically cold-call and use high pressure sales techniques. A recent development has been the inclusion of Financial Advisors who specialise in providing financial advice for people in later life and can help with matters like care fees, pensions and investments.

WARNING FROM TRADING STANDARDS ABOUT UNHEALTHY SHAKES

Drinks being sold in Derbyshire have been found to contain almost an entire day's worth of calories – and more than the recommended daily amounts of sugar and saturated fat.

Residents are being advised to limit the number of 'freak shakes' they consume after our survey revealed the very high levels of calories, sugar and saturated fat. Freak shakes are milkshakes topped with a selection of things like waffles, whipped cream, shortbread, muffins, doughnuts, sprinkles and sauce, with extras like gingerbread or eclairs on the side.

The examples looked at by trading standards officers contained between 474 calories and 1,730 calories per 'drink'.

The recommended daily intake for men is about 2,500 calories, 2,000 for women, and lower for children, depending on age, gender and how active they are.

Officers analysed samples from the freak shakes and found some of them contained between 14 and 44 teaspoons of sugar per serving.

Government guidelines state adults should have no more than seven and a half teaspoons of sugar per day, children aged seven to 10-years-old six teaspoons and children aged four to six-years-old almost five teaspoons.

The shakes were also found to contain between 9g and 47g of saturated fat per serving. Most had more than 18g.

The Government recommends that men should not have more than 30g saturated fat per day, women 20g and children should have less than that, though no figure is specified.

Derbyshire County Council Cabinet Member for Health and Communities, Councillor Carol Hart, said "Our aim is to raise awareness of food content so consumers are confident they know what they're buying. These drinks contain more calories than some meals, with some of them having a full day's quota. All of them contain more sugar than is recommended per day. Most had more saturated fat than is advised. "We are not saying people should never consume these freak shakes but it is important that they are aware of how much saturated fat and sugar they contain so that they can make an informed choice."

Freak shakes are sometimes also known as cake shakes, dream shakes, and super shakes.


